Adjacent grade samples may be used where there are fewer than two examples in a given grade level.</p>					
10 - 15	3 (20 - 30% at risk moderated)	1	1	1	Represents grades across the distribution but a lower proportion of these
<p>Instructions: Random selection of one (1) sample of student assessments graded a fail, one (1) sample of student assessment graded a pass or credit or distinction, one (1) sample of student assessment graded a high distinction (a total of 3 pieces of work).</p>					
9 or less	Between 2 - 1 (30% at risk moderated)	1 (where there is an example)	0	1 (if there is an example)	Only moderates at risk grades
<p>Instructions: Random selection of only at risk graded assessments (fail or high distinction). Where there are no fails or high distinction grades assigned no moderation will be undertaken.</p>					

*Recommended to moderate assessment tasks where task weighting is greater than 10%.
